



Manitoba Little Buckaroos Rodeo

The Manitoba Little Buckaroos is a division of Manitoba High School Rodeo Association which allows for school aged children from Kindergarten to Grade 5 to participate in youth rodeo events.

These events include both mounted and unmounted events such as; barrel racing, pole bending, goat tying, goat undecorating, mutton busting, calf riding, dummy roping and mechanical bucky riding. Events will vary with stock availability. Rodeos will held on MHSRA rodeo weekends at participating rodeo locations.

There are 2 age groups for boys and girls combined:

Group 1 – Kindergarten to Grade 2

Group 2 – Grade 3 to Grade 5

Rodeo fees are \$20/contestant. \$5 goes covers the insurance cost and the remaining \$15 covers stock fees and prizes. Every little buckaroo will get a prize following the Little Buckaroos rodeo.

All contestants must be in western attire; cowboy boots, jeans, long-sleeved button up shirt, cowboy hat or riding helmet. No hooded jackets or hoodies in the arena at any time.

Helmets are optional for mounted events based on the discretion of the parents. Stock events require protective gear provided by the parent; helmets, vest and calf ropes. If you don't have your own, please try to borrow from someone you know.

All horses should be suited for the contestants riding ability. **NO LEADLINE.** Parents may run beside their child if needed.

All tack should be safe and checked by parents before mounting,

All animal welfare policies as outlined by NHSRA will also be in effect for Little Buckaroo Rodeos.
