



2018/19 MHSRA Grocery Voucher Fundraiser

MHSRA Members & Parents

Fund raising is a very important part of MHSRA. These funds are used to keep our association operating. This fall, the MHSRA will once again have this as our major fundraiser. With our membership a deposit cheque of \$100.00 is also needed to be included (per member). A motion was passed at AGM that all members are required to sell a minimum of \$1000.00 in grocery vouchers or write a cheque of \$100.00 to the MHSRA when the membership is purchased. If you sell your \$1000.00 in grocery vouchers your cheque will be returned to you and if you only sell a portion of that, the cheque will then be returned accordingly.

Various grocery stores are on board again this year. Each member may sell for any or all the stores. So if your local grocery store is not listed but you have family/friends that have one of the participating stores in their community – give them a call see if they will participate. If your local grocery store is not listed – please contact us and we can give you a letter to take to the store to see if they will come on board. There is a letter on our website for you to copy off and give to that particular store explaining how it works.

This fundraiser involves the selling of grocery vouchers. The various stores give back to the association different percentages ranging from 5 – 10% - so for example if you sell \$1,000 worth of vouchers our association will receive anywhere from \$50 to \$100. Any amount that you sell over \$2,000 – a portion will go to the scholarship account – held in your name until you graduate. This is a win-win situation for all involved as the person buying the vouchers pays \$100 and receives the full \$100 in vouchers (does not cost them one cent) and the MHSRA receives 5 – 10% from the sale.

All vouchers/credits must be pre-paid. You can print off the sheets to the stores that you will be selling for off of our website – you have until the Beausejour Rodeo to work on selling vouchers. You must turn your sheets and money in at the Beausejour Rodeo Sept 7, 2018. If you can help at all with vouchers in Beausejour Friday night please let Rita know. We will have the vouchers ready for each member to pick up at Oak Lake Rodeo Sept. 15 & 16th, so you can take them back and distribute the vouchers to whom you sold. PLEASE MAKE SURE YOU MAKE A COPY OF YOUR SHEETS BECAUSE WE KEEP THEM FOR OUR RECORDS AND YOU WILL NEED TO KNOW WHO AND HOW MUCH YOUR CUSTOMERS ARE GETTING BACK WHEN YOU RETURN THEIR GROCERY VOUCHERS. VERY IMPORTANT!!!
